

Animal skeletons

Potential ways to use the animal skeletons:

- > Compare similarities and differences between the animals
- > Introduce the scientific names of the bones and use the blank copies to test people's retention of the words
- > Read out or give a list of the bones and have people colour in where they are on the animal
- > Simplify the bone names and have learners identify them on the blank animal skeletons

Simplified bone names:

- Skull/head
- Jaw
- Neck
- Shoulder
- Spine/back
- Ribs
- Tail
- Hip
- Upper leg
- Lower leg
- Knee
